NDIS pricing arrangements and price limits allows providers like
National 360 to charge for Provider
Travel when a therapist travels to you to provide Allied Health services.




What does Provider Travel include?
Provider travel may include Labour
Costs (Time) and Non-Labour Cost
(Expenses)



Labour Cost is the travel time it takes a therapist to come to you and sometimes it may also include return travel.

If you and other participants agree, the travel time can be shared equally between all the participants who have appointments with your therapist for the day, including the return travel.




Your **service agreement** explains how this is charged.

The **hourly rate** for Labour Cost is **\$193.99.**



Non-Labour Cost means the expenses that occur when a therapist travels to you. This includes money spent on road tolls, parking fees, and the expenses of running a vehicle.

This charge is **calculated** by adding **kilometers travelled** to you. The **rate** is \$1.05 per kilometer.



What is the **CHANGE** for me?

You will see **Non-Labour Cost** on your National 360 **invoices** from **31**st **July 2023**

We expect this change to have a **minor impact** on the funds you planned for the services.
